

## CHAPTER 29

### PROJECTIONS OVER PAVEMENTS OR SIDEWALKS

#### SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to erect any structure or projection of whatsoever nature or kind that shall extend upon or over the limits of any pavement or sidewalk as now used or to be established by law within the Town of Williamsport.

However, any projection that is erected nine (9') feet or more above the pavement or sidewalk, may be remitted upon application to the Mayor and Council provided that same shall not project more than two (2') feet over the limits of said pavement or sidewalk, exclusive of the cornice. Prior to the erection of said projection, a written application shall first be made to the Mayor and Council of the Town for a permit to construct such projection, accompanied by a plan of same. The Mayor and Council shall within their absolute discretion either approve or disapprove construction of said project.

#### SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

Projection for purposes of this Ordinance shall be defined as bay windows, closed porches, open porches, canopies, steps and projections of any kind whatsoever.

#### SECTION 3. REMEDIES

In addition to the penalties provided for in Chapter I, Article III of the Code of the Town of Williamsport, the Mayor and Council upon notification in writing by any person residing in the Town of Williamsport, any person is or are erecting or is or are about to erect a projection in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall within its discretion, after proper investigation, institute such legal proceedings either in law or in equity as may be necessary, to prohibit, enjoin and stop the erection of said projection.
