Request for Proposals 2022-10 L. Beard Miller Memorial Pool Rehabilitation Project

The Town of Williamsport invites the submittal of responses to this Request for Proposals (RFP) from qualified firms interested in providing labor, materials, supplies, and equipment to rehabilitate the L. Beard Miller Memorial Pool located within Byron Memorial Park at 11 Park Road, Williamsport, Maryland. The Town intends to consider Firms and/or individuals who possess the professional and administrative capabilities to provide the scope of services detailed within the bid package available on our website at www.williamsportmd.gov. This Request for Proposals is being released to ensure ongoing services with respect to the responsible use of tax dollars. The Town's Elected Officials will participate in the process of selecting the appropriate firm.

The Town of Williamsport reserves the right to allow for the clarification of questionable entries and for the correction of obvious mistakes, to reject submittals containing any additional terms or conditions not specifically requested in the original Scope of Work, and to reject any or all proposals, and waive informalities as may be deemed in the best interest of the Town.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS 2022-10: L. Beard Miller Memorial Pool Rehabilitation Project

I. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Town of Williamsport invites the submittal of responses to this Request for Proposals (RFP) from qualified firms interested in providing labor, materials, supplies, and equipment to rehabilitate the L. Beard Miller Memorial Pool located within Byron Memorial Park.

The pool measures approximately 100 feet by 50 feet with various depths ranging from 1½' entry area to 10 feet. Estimates of exact area to be serviced will be discussed at the pre-bid meeting and specifically identified by potential contractors as part of their bid submission. Each potential contractor is expected to provide their own measurements to determine cost estimates. Currently, the Town completes patchwork for areas of concern prior to opening each season.

II. CALENDAR OF EVENTS

Any submissions received after the receipt date and time will not be accepted.

<u>Pre-Bid Meeting</u>: Friday, October 3, 2022, at 10:00 AM in the Planning & Zoning Board Conference Room at Town Hall. Any potential bidder not in attendance at the Pre-Bid Meeting, may request a copy of any and all written addendums based on discussion at the Pre-Bid meeting and submitted written questions and are encouraged to schedule a time to meet with Town staff and complete an on-site visit.

<u>Sealed Bids</u>: Due by Friday, November 4, 2022, by 3:30 PM. Envelopes must be delivered or mailed to Town Manager, L. Beard Miller Memorial Pool Rehabilitation Project, 2 North Conocochague Street, Williamsport, MD 21795. The Town reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

<u>Bid Opening</u>: All submitted bids will be opened at the November 7, 2022, meeting of the Mayor & Town Council. The Town Manager will unseal and read aloud required documents of each submitted proposal.

<u>Bid Award</u>: The Mayor & Town Council will then consider each bid and make a formal decision at the November 14, 2022, meeting of the Mayor & Town Council. The Mayor & Town Council reserve the right to decide to approve a proposal at any Special Session scheduled between the November and December meetings. The Town Manager will contact the awardee and provide a letter to unsuccessful bidders within 7 days of the approval.

III. SCOPE OF WORK

A. The Town of Williamsport has an aging community swimming pool and is seeking to rehabilitate the walls and floor of the entire pool shell. Generally, the Scope of Work will include removal of current surface, repair of deficient areas of pool walls, floors, and coping, and

installation of new primer and protective coating of pool shell. Work shall include the replacement of ladders, handrails, and drain covers.

The approved contractor shall:

- Drain the pool to remove existing protective coating and accessories from pool shell; and
- Provide rehabilitation to identified areas of concern in consultation with Town staff; and
- Remove and install new expansion joint; and
- Properly and effectively fill all cracks and depressions with guidance from Town staff; and
- Identify and effectively maintenance hollow spots; and
- Install drain frames and new drain covers for the primary drains in the deepest section of the pool in compliance with the Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act; and
- Following all repairs, apply primer and protective coating to pool walls and floor; and
- Ensure all areas of correction are addressed prior to refilling the pool; and
- Care will be taken to ensure care of the pool deck, any damages to the pool deck will be repaired by the contractor at no additional cost to the Town.
- B. The contractor shall be responsible for all supplies and materials, equipment, and other necessary apparatus to complete the project. Storage of supplies, materials, equipment, and apparatus will be at a designated location determined by the approved contractor and Town staff.
- C. The contractor shall be responsible to ensure all work follows federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances and will be responsible for the costs associated with corrections of work should any work be found not to be in compliance.
- D. The contractor shall be responsible to drain the pool with respect to federal, state, and local laws and regulations including Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4). The contractor will work with Town staff to refill the pool once all work has been completed and inspected by Town staff.
- E. Contractor will be responsible for disposal of any items and materials not being reused within the scope of this project.
- F. The work site will be clean and organized at the end of each workday. Rubbish, empty refuse cans, rags, and other such materials will be clear of the work site each day. A storage area will be determined by both the approved contractor and the Town for equipment, supplies, and materials.
- G. The timeline for approval of a submission is outlined in Section I; as part of the approvals the Town will work with the approved contractor to select a start date. The project must be completed no later than May 5, 2023. This will allow for the Town to prepare for opening for the summer pool season.
- H. Following the 2023 summer pool season, a meeting between the Town and contractor will occur to evaluate the work completed and make repairs. The contractor will be expected to make repairs at no additional cost to the Town.

I. The contractor should note as part of their submission, a warranty for an number of years should be specifically noted.

IV. MATERIALS

- A. Provide the best quality grade of coatings as regularly manufactured by acceptable coating manufacturers. Materials not displaying manufacturer's identification as a best grade product will not be acceptable. The material should be manufactured for submerged environmental conditions including chlorine and muriatic acid.
- B. Submissions will be accepted using a coating surface other than a quartz, but preference will be given to submissions including a quartz coating surface.
- C. Submission will be accepted using materials for handrails, ladders, and other such items will be accepted, but preference will be given to items made of heavy duty, commercial grade stainless steel products.

The BIDDER hereby agrees to commence WORK under this Contract on or before a date to be specified in the NOTICE OF AWARD / NOTICE TO PROCEED and to fully complete the PROJECT within the time set forth. The CONTRACTOR further agrees to pay liquidated damages for each consecutive calendar day thereafter.
The CONTRACTOR agrees to execute a Contract for the work as awarded at the lump sum amount quoted in the bid proposal and further guarantees completion within the time stipulated with allowances for any extensions of time that may be approved.
The CONTRACTOR hereby states that he has available adequate equipment and finances to prosecute the work properly and expeditiously as bid and is prepared to present further information to substantiate this statement.
The CONTRACTOR further covenants and warrants that he has examined the site of the work; that he has had sufficient time to examine the site of the work to determine the character of the subsurface material and conditions to be encountered; and that he has based the contract prices on his own independent examination and investigation of the site, subsurface materials, and conditions, and has not relied on any subsurface information furnished to him by the Owner.
The CONTRACTOR agrees to do everything required to perform all work necessary for, or incidental to, and to perform all other obligations imposed by this Agreement for the full and just Lump sum of dollars
