Town of Williamsport Mayor & Town Council Public Hearing: Utility Rate Increase – June 5, 2023

On June 5, 2023, the Mayor & Town Council for the Town of Williamsport held a Public Hearing to accept public comment on the proposed utility rate increase. Those members of the elected body who were present included Mayor William Green, Assistant Mayor Dennis Grove, Councilman Jim Braswell, Councilperson Tinsley, Councilman Charles Brown, Councilman Pereschuk, and Councilperson Margaret Yaukey. Town employees in attendance included Chad Rooney, Town Manager; Kathrine Gratton, Circuit Rider/Grant Writer, and Ed Kuczynski, Town Attorney

Mayor Green called the meeting to order at 6:45pm.

The Mayor presented the need to increase utility rates based on a study completed in the summer/fall of 2022. The rates were increased in late 2022 and again as part of the fiscal year budget. The next proposed increase would not occur until the passing of Fiscal Year 2025 budgets.





Town of Williamsport June 5, 2023; Public Hearing - FY 2024 Utility Rates Public Sign-In Log



CHAPTER 34

A ORDIANCE REGULATING RATES OF WATER AND SEWER USAGE IN THE TOWN OF WILLIAMSPORT

The Mayor and Town Council, as the duly constituted legislative body, after having held a public hearing, have determined that it is in the best interests of the Town of Williamsport and the citizenry in general to revise certain water and/or sewage fees as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESLOVED, ENACTED and ORDAINED THAT Chapter 34 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING RATES OF WATER AND SEWER USAGE IN THE TOWN OF WILLIAMSPORT", be and is hereby revoked; and

Be it further RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED that said Chapter 34, AN ORDIANCE REGATULATING RATES OF WATER AND SEWER USAGE IN TOWN OF WILLIAMSPORT is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

CHAPTER 34

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING RATES OF WATER AND SEAGE USAGE AND CONNECTION FEES IN THE TOWN OF WILLAMSPORT

A. CITY WATER Customers within the corporate limits who have water

service. Charges are \$11.14 for Residential Customers and \$11.77 for Commercial Customers per 1,000 gallons of

water used.

B. CITY SEWER Customers within the corporate limits who have sewer

service. Charges are \$15.75 for Residential and Commercial

Customers per 1,000 gallons of water used.

C. CITY WATER/SEWER Customers within the corporate limits who have water and

sewer service. Charges are \$11.14 for Residential Customers and \$11.77 for Commercial Customers per 1,000 gallons of water used and \$15.75 per 1,000 gallons for sewer

(based on water usage).

D. COUNTY WATER Customers outside the corporate limits who have water

service. Charges are \$18.71 for Residential Customers and \$22.19 for Commercial Customers per 1,000 gallons of

water used.

E. COUNTY SEWER Customers outside the corporate limits who have sewer service. Charges are \$24.98 for Residential and Commercial

Customers per 1,000 gallons of water used.

F. COUNTY WATER/SEWER

Customers outside the corporate limits who have water and sewer service. Charges are \$18.71 for Residential Customers and \$22.19 for Commercial Customers per 1,000 gallons of water used and \$24.98 per 1,000 gallons for sewer (based on water usage).

G. WATER FOR SALE

Customers who resell water. Charges are \$14.30 per 1,000 gallons after the minimum 2,000 gallons have been used.

MINIMUM (2,000 gallons): \$21.62 for in-town water usage and \$34.15 for out-of-town water usage; \$31.50 for intown sewage usage and \$49.96 for out-of-town sewage usage.

The Mayor and Town Council, by Resolution, can elect to bill water and sewer customers on a monthly or quarterly basis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, ENACTED, and ORDAINED that this Ordinance has been introduced and passed to be considered effective on January 1, 2023.
