Each spring, the C&O Canal Trust recruits and engages hundreds of volunteers to complete a range of preservation, beautification, maintenance, and conservation projects along the 184.5-mile length of the C&O Canal National Historical Park, from Washington, DC to Cumberland, Maryland.

The Trust works closely with Park staff to identify priorities and create projects for volunteers of all ages and abilities, including students earning service credit hours.

Projects include invasive species removal, picnic area improvements, towpath repairs, historic preservation maintenance, trash removal, and native planting.

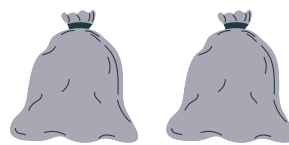
