



**Town of Williamsport
Mayor & Town Council
Regular Session Meeting Minutes
April 7, 2025**

On April 7, 2025, the Mayor & Town Council for the Town of Williamsport held a Work Session. Those members of the elected body who were present included Mayor William Green, Assistant Mayor Dennis Grove, Councilman Ball (by phone), Councilman Jim Braswell, Councilman Charles Brown, Councilman Earle Pereschuk, and Councilman Tinsley. Town employees in attendance were Chad Rooney, Town Manager, and Ed Kuczynski, Town Attorney.

Mayor Green called the meeting to order at 6:01pm.

Mayor Green and the Town Manager presented information to Town Council on an agreement with Park Mobile including a review of the fee structure, implementation, and potential impacts for users. Currently Town Council took official action to have the Mayor sign the agreement, but both the Mayor and Town Manager wanted Town Council to offer insight prior to signing. The item will be placed on the April Regular Session Agenda for consideration.

The Town Manager asked for guidance on the Town signing on as a participating member of the Maryland Utilities Alliance to promote legislation and items to the Maryland general Assembly. Williamsport is the only municipal electric utility owner not participating and it would greatly benefit the town. The item will be on the April Regular Session Agenda for consideration.

Mayor Green provided information on Placer.ai which is an artificial intelligence platform tracking app users for the purpose of economic development information. It was agreed the information should be provided to business owners who can determine the importance and need for their own participation.

Mayor Green outlined information related to the 2025 Carnival. He requested official action as money will need to be spent on musical acts and food. The item will be placed on the April regular Session Agenda for consideration.

Mayor Green asked for a motion to adjourn. Councilman Tinsley made a motion to adjourn the Regular Session; Councilman Pereschuk seconded; the meeting was adjourned at 6:44pm.
